Droitwich Music and Arts Festival on Saturday, July 10 - A range of activities and events will be on offer in Droitwich town centre on Saturday, July 10 as part of Droitwich Music and Arts Festival. Sarah James (aka Mrs Leavesley or Daniel and James's Mum), who runs poetry workshops as part of the school's Friday 'university afternoon' sessions, will be organising a **collaborative haiku project** in the town centre from 10am to 5pm. The project, which includes **free, drop-in haiku workshops**, will give adults and children the chance to write (and illustrate) their own haiku -roughly, a short three-line poem (see the example given below). Written on leaves and flower petals these poems will then be added to a **display, creating a giant picture of flowers and leaves**.
